Art Committee members reserve the right to refuse pieces that do not meet minimum standards for subject matter, framing, etc., as outlined below.

Type of Art - Original works and limited edition prints will be considered for display.

The following media are acceptable:

Oil/Acrylic	Pencil/Pen	Photography
Watercolor	Collage/Glass	Pastels/Charcoal

Subject Matter All artwork must be tasteful, as determined by the Art Committee. No violence, explicit nudes, etc. **BAE reserves the right to refuse any artwork.**

Size Minimum: 8" x 10" Maximum: 36" x 40"

Framing Criteria -All artwork must be framed as described below:

FRAMES - Must be in good condition. Frames must have hanging wire (no toothed hangers) and must be of proper strength for artwork weight. Works on stretched canvas may be framed or unframed if canvas sides are part of the painting. No staples may show on the sides.

MATS - Works on paper must be matted.

GLASS / PLEXIGLAS - Works on paper must be covered with glass or Plexiglas; clean and no scratches.

Each artist must complete two BAE SYSTEMS forms per piece. Tape the double form to the center of the wire.
