NCSFA members, 1 entry @ \$20, 2 entries @ \$25, 3 entries @ \$28

Non-members, 1 entry @ \$25, 2 entries @ \$30, 3 entries @ \$33

Prize money:

Total prize money is \$1,075 awarded to 15 artworks, namely, \$125 to best in show, \$100 first place awards, \$75 second place awards and \$50 third place awards in each of four categories, plus \$25 for the Fay award and \$25 for the Slattery award.

Categories:

Category 1 is oil or acrylic on canvas or board, not covered with glass or plexiglass.

Category 2 is watercolor, including Chinese Brush, or acrylic under glass or plexiglass.

Category 3 is photography, pen & ink, pastel and prints.

Category 4 is sculpture including gourds and ceramics with sculptural value, collage and mixed media.

If the number of entrants in each category is uneven, which would affect the ratio of prize money to categories, the mediums within each category will be exchanged to approximate most even distribution.

Qualifications: Artwork must not have been previously shown at PCPA, must be original, and not obviously done under a teacher's guidance. Maximum framed size is 4' X 4'. Weight no more than 10 lb.

For wooden frames, use screw eyes with opening of 1/4", positioned on the vertical sides of the frame from 1 and a half to 2 inches from the top. The hole in the screw eyes should be parallel to the ceiling.

Hanging wire is not necessary for PCPA's hanging system.

For metal frames, move the vertical side pieces which have a hole in which the hook in PCPA's hanging system will fit to the top of the channel. Do not remove the hanging wire.

Commission: The only commission is 15% to the Poway Center for the Performing Arts. This applies also to the cards and matted or small framed work you may sell at the reception. Portfolio standing racks and display stands are available for your use. You are responsible for sales.

Liability: Neither the North County Society of Fine Arts, nor its officers, agents or representatives, nor the Poway Center for the Performing Arts, nor the city of Poway assume any liability for damage, theft or loss of entered artwork. Your art will be cared for, but insurance is the responsibility of the exhibiting artist.
