NCSFA Members are pleased to be invited to exhibit their artwork at the Rancho Bernardo Presbyterian Community Church Art Gallery. The theme of the show "Living Water" was selected by the Church art committee.

REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION:

Entry Limits: 2D or/and 3D media will be accepted. Members are encouraged to enter 2 pieces of artwork each. Three pieces of artwork is the maximum per member.

<u>Fees:</u> A donation of \$20 for 1, 2 or 3 pieces of artwork is requested as a donation to the church art program.

Awards: There will be \$100 first place, \$75 second place, and \$50 third place.

The "congregational favorite" and honorable mention awards or certificates may be awarded at the discretion of the jurors.

<u>Size Limit:</u> No piece smaller that 12 inches or larger than 60 inches on any side, frame included. Exceptions for sizes for 3D work. (Keep in mind the size of the gallery space in the church.)

<u>Framing</u>: All work must be framed, wired, and ready to hang. No sawtooth hangers and no eye hooks. D rings are preferred. Exception: Works on wrapped canvas with no staples showing do not need to be framed.

Note: All artwork must be family friendly and appropriate for a church setting.

Artwork may be available for sale but prices will not be displayed on the labels. A list of artwork and prices will be available in the portfolio book along with the artist contact information which will be displayed on the label.

Important Dates:

Deadline to sign up on line <u>www,ncsfa.org</u> is **June 12th Monday** at Midnight. No digital image is required.

Take in will be 9 am to 10:30 am on June 17 Saturday. Each member delivers their artwork to the church. Hanging of the show will be done 11 am to 1 pm. Judging will be done 11am to 3 pm.

A Reception will be held Sunday June 18 from 10:30 to 11:30 am between services.

Pick up for artwork will be August 12th Saturday, 9 am to 10:30 am.
